

## Anna Carroll's Class List

\*All classes can be modified into a one day masterclass, 4 to 5 day summer course, or 6-10 week semester course and contain a performance on the final day of class.\*

### Audition Prep Kids / Teens (Ages 8-12 / 13-18)

This week's intensive is musical theater specific. We will explore how to prepare for an audition from beginning to end: song choice, acting, vocals, confidence, attire, and more! The last day will include mock auditions and feedback. \*Please come prepared with two song choices. Students may submit song choice with a video clip before the week of the intensive if desired.

### Storytelling 101 (Ages 11-18)

In this course we will learn how to use improvisation to create original work both individually and as an ensemble. Come ready to risk, create, and challenge yourself to think outside your comfort zone!

-supplies: pens, paper, the occasional print out (or students can bring their own journals)

### Harmony 101 (Ages 8-12 / 13-18)

Do you love to sing? Do you love singing with other people? In this course, we will learn the basic techniques of harmonizing and blending while creating a fun, student led performance. (Song choices will be chosen based on the students' strengths and musical interests. Solo opportunities available but not required).

### How to Build a Character (Ages 8-12 / 13-18)

Explore movement, story, and varying acting techniques behind building a character.

### Acting Through Song (Ages 13-18)

Join us for character building, vocal instruction, and storytelling through music.

### The Great Create (Ages 13-18)

Have you wondered how to write and create a show from scratch? Where to start? Where to begin?! Join us for this fast paced week of all things theater where we will explore how to build a show from beginning to end. From writing to production and beyond!

### Beginner Improv (Ages 8-13)

Let's play! In this course we will learn the basic rules of improvisation and working as an ensemble.

### Intermediate Improv (Ages 13-18)

Come ready to risk, create, and challenge yourself to think outside your comfort zone! In this class we will learn improv techniques and exercises then apply them to create short sketches. Think, Saturday Night Live, but created by you and your friends.

## Acting and Scene Work (Ages 13-18)

Students will learn character building, blocking, and other aspects of scene work with both monologues and group scenes.

## SUMMER SPECIFIC PROGRAMMING / DAY CAMPS:

### Vocal Bootcamp Kids / Teens (Ages 8-12 / 13-18)

This high energy course will strengthen, challenge, and grow students in all things voice! Come join the competition and get your voice in shape! \*Students interested in solo singing should come prepared with a short cut (one minute or so) of a song \*Family and friends will be invited to a short performance on the final day of class.

#### SUPPLIES:

- small trophies / medals
- small white board and dry erase markers

- jump rope, baskets, anything for an obstacle course. What do we have already?

### Musical Theatre Kids (Ages 8-12)

Sing, dance, and act! This week we will explore all things musical theater with fun group numbers and a performance on the last day of class! \*Solo opportunities available. \*Family and friends will be invited to a short performance on the final day of class.

### Build a Puppet (Ages 6-10) \*one time class, 2 hrs

Join Ms. Anna in a fun, creative, craft class where we will design our own deluxe sock puppets and learn the basic techniques of puppetry and character building!

#### SUPPLIES

- bag of men's adult socks, cardboard, scissors, sharpie, fluff (for teacher only) / foam shapes, googly eyes, buttons, scraps of material/fabric/felt/fuzz/foam sheets (used as clothes and hair or mustaches), foam shapes, pipe cleaners, any fun craft items organization may already have, hot glue gun, hot glue
- \*teacher assistant needed to use hot glue gun

### On the Town (Ages 15-18) \*Weekly collaborative meeting

Fridays 6-8pm, \$15 to attend, food provided, must register in advance for food purposes but students are encouraged to bring friends. First time, \$5 at the door to join.

## Private Lessons

### Private Voice Lessons

Weekly lessons to expand vocal health, talent, and technique

30 mins - \$40-45 weekly (based on location)

1Hr - \$80 weekly

\*Payments are made on a monthly basis

### Acting Coaching (monthly or one-off)

Work through monologues or songs to develop acting technique

30 mins - \$45

45 mins - \$65

### Audition Prep (one-off lessons)

Instructor will aid in song choice, sheet music purchase(included), and overall prep for singing/acting auditions

45 mins - \$80

1hr - \$90 \*recommended length

90 mins - \$130
